Whether it is facing our fears on the high ropes, challenging ourselves on a sunset hike up to Baldy, or having the courage to share our stories, as we step out in faith, we are met by the support of this

community and the God who calls us all beloved."

Summer Staff: Prior to camper arrival each

summer, our college-aged summer staff come together to build a close-knit community, learning to work as a team as they prepare to mentor and care for campers.

Staff training includes: facilitating program areas such as high ropes, the lake, archery, and the nature center; hands-on experience with multiple staff overnights;

learning to lead bible study and worship; risk management; abuse prevention; supporting campers with neurodivergence; conflict resolution; trauma-informed care; cultural competency; and more.

Our intentional staff training empowers our staff to embrace their role of upholding BCC's mission and values,

while serving as leaders in sharing our community's culture with the next generation.
